

Ranks and Recognitions



The first rank that EVERY boy MUST earn when entering Cub Scouting is the Bobcat rank. To earn the Bobcat rank the new Cub Scout must do the following:

- Learn and say the **CUB SCOUT PROMISE**.
- Say the **LAW OF THE PACK**. Tell what it means.
- Tell what **WEBELOS** means.
- Show the **CUB SCOUT SIGN**.
- Show the **CUB SCOUT HANDSHAKE**.
- Say the **CUB SCOUT MOTTO**.
- Give the **CUB SCOUT SALUTE**.
- With your parent or guardian, complete the exercises in the booklet, **How to Protect Your Children from Child Abuse**.

Your Cub Scout manual also has important information about child protection that each parent will need to read by themselves, and then go over information they want to share with their child.

TIGER CUB IMMEDIATE RECOGNITION

Tiger Cub Immediate Recognition Emblem:

- 1) Learn the Tiger Cub Motto
- 2) Learn the Cub Scout Sign
- 3) Learn the Cub Scout Salute

*There is a tiger paw print on [page 161](#) that can be colored (with a pencil is best) when you accomplish these three things.

On [page 162](#) there are achievements on the tiger cub trail that can help you track your progress toward earning the Tiger rank. You can color these tracks in with a pencil as you go down the tiger trail. This helps you see at a glance what you have accomplished and what you still need to do to earn your rank.



As you participate in **Family, Den, and Go-See-It** activities and those items have been completed, you can pencil in the paw prints on [page 162](#).

When all fifteen activities have been completed, you have earned your Tiger rank!

You can now go on to do the Tiger Track Trail electives. You can work on any of your electives at any time, but you cannot receive Tiger Track elective beads until you have earned your Tiger rank.

For every 10 electives you accomplish you will earn a Tiger Track Bead.
